| <b>ASSESSMENT METHODS</b> | The final exam will be oral; three questions minimum. The evaluation of the oral examination will be made on the basis of following grid. -Excellent 30 -30 cum laude: good knowledge of the topics, excellent language, excellent capacity of analysis ; the student is able to apply theoretical knowledge to real cases which are proposed to be analysed. He/she is also able to properly argue possible solution, including multiple alternatives - Very good 26-29: good knowledge of the topics, good properties 'of language, good capacity' analytical; the student is 'able to apply theoretical knowledge to real cases which are proposed to be analysed.
